The award recipient will receive \$1000 scholarship sponsored by Umpqua Bank and will be honored at the Derby Days Grand Parade on Saturday, July 9, 2016.

### Eligibility:

- Must be a U.S. citizen and a Redmond resident
- High school senior
- Be in good academic standing; minimum of 2.0 cumulative grade point average at his/her high school
- Must be present at Derby Days parade on Saturday, July 9, 2016 for parade participation and award. (Grand Parade starts at 11am)
- Relatives of the selection committee are ineligible to receive the award

- Application form
- 500 Word essay
- School transcript
- Two recommendations from Redmond community members

### Essay requirements:

- Please submit a 500 word essay explaining how community service (volunteering) has impacted your life. Give specific examples surrounding your volunteer work.
